1. The phrasing has, in the main, been omitted. This is partly for the sake of clarity, and partly because the phrasing is self-evident.
2. The 'Prayer' was originally composed with clarinet obbligato. The dotted lines link the notes in the original clarinet score as far as bar 10. Thereafter it is a matter of 'quaerendo invenietis' to search for the counter melody!
3. "Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam" ("To the Greater Glory of God"). AMDG is the motto of the Jesuit founder, Saint Ignatius of Loyola.
